SESSION ITEMS FROM JULY

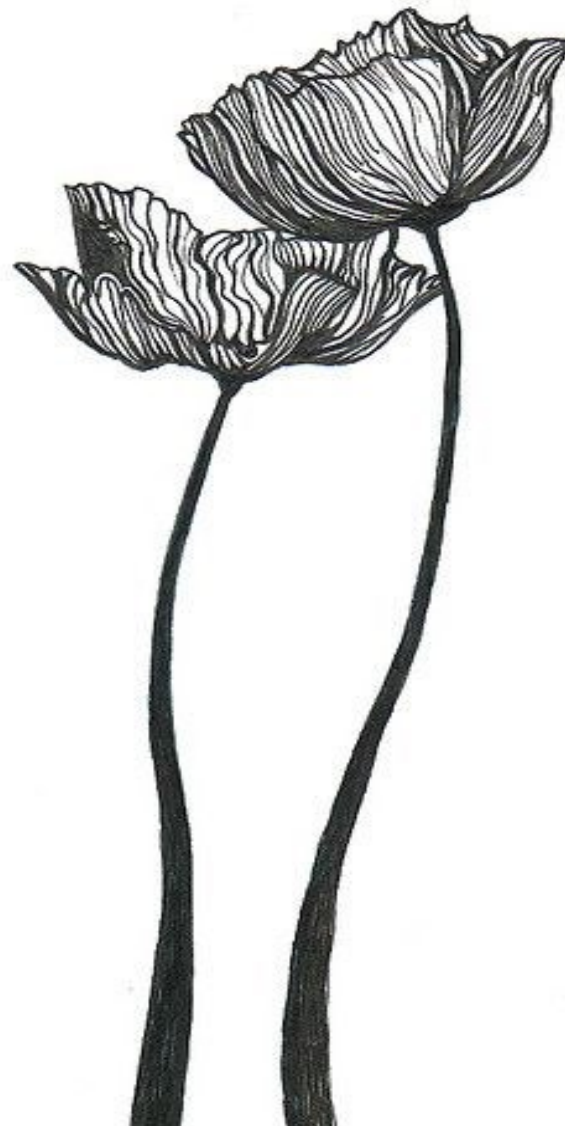
1. Elder Tim Wieskamp from Bethel OPC, Oostburg, WI. was a guest for part of the meeting.
