AN OPPORTUNITY

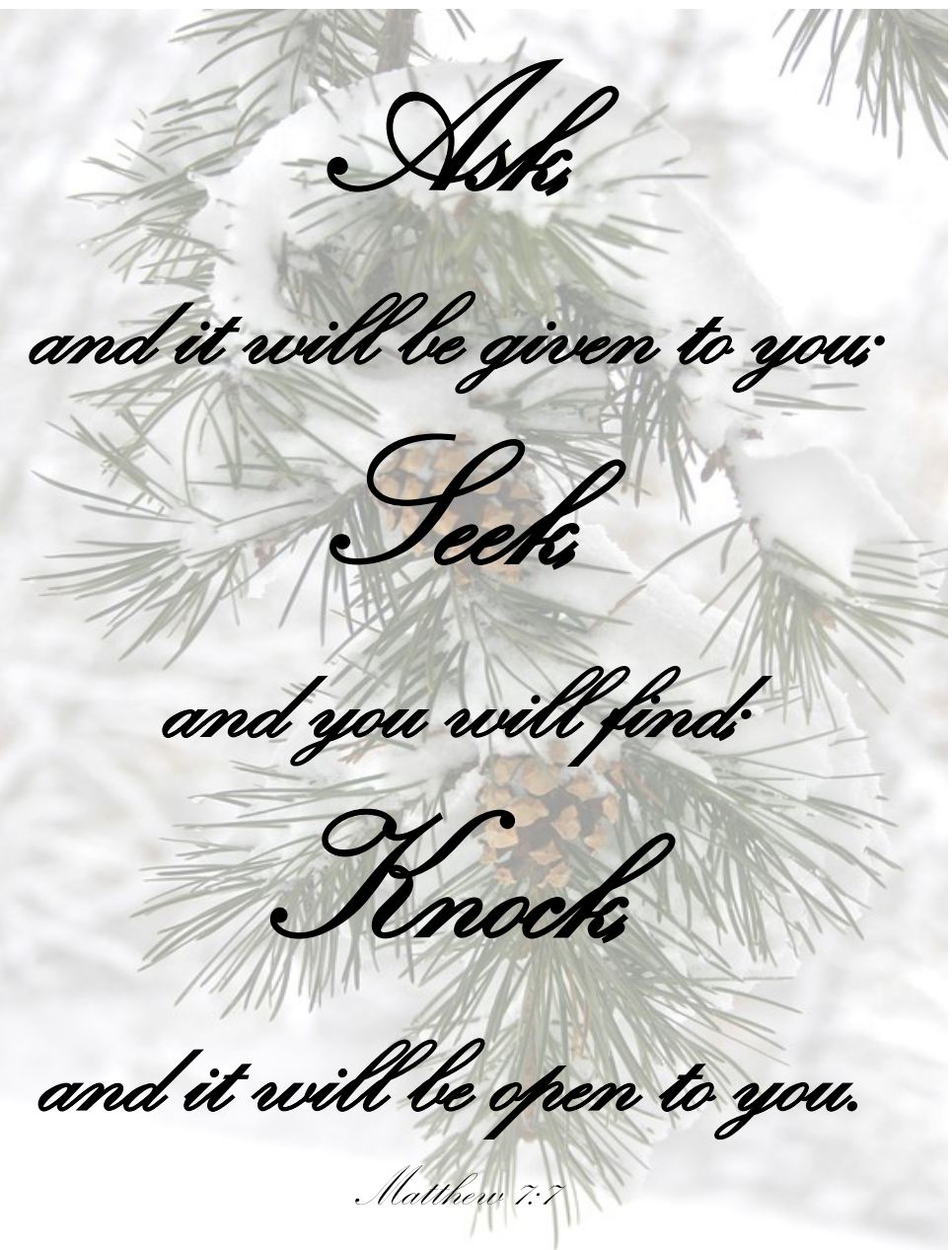
