MISSIONS

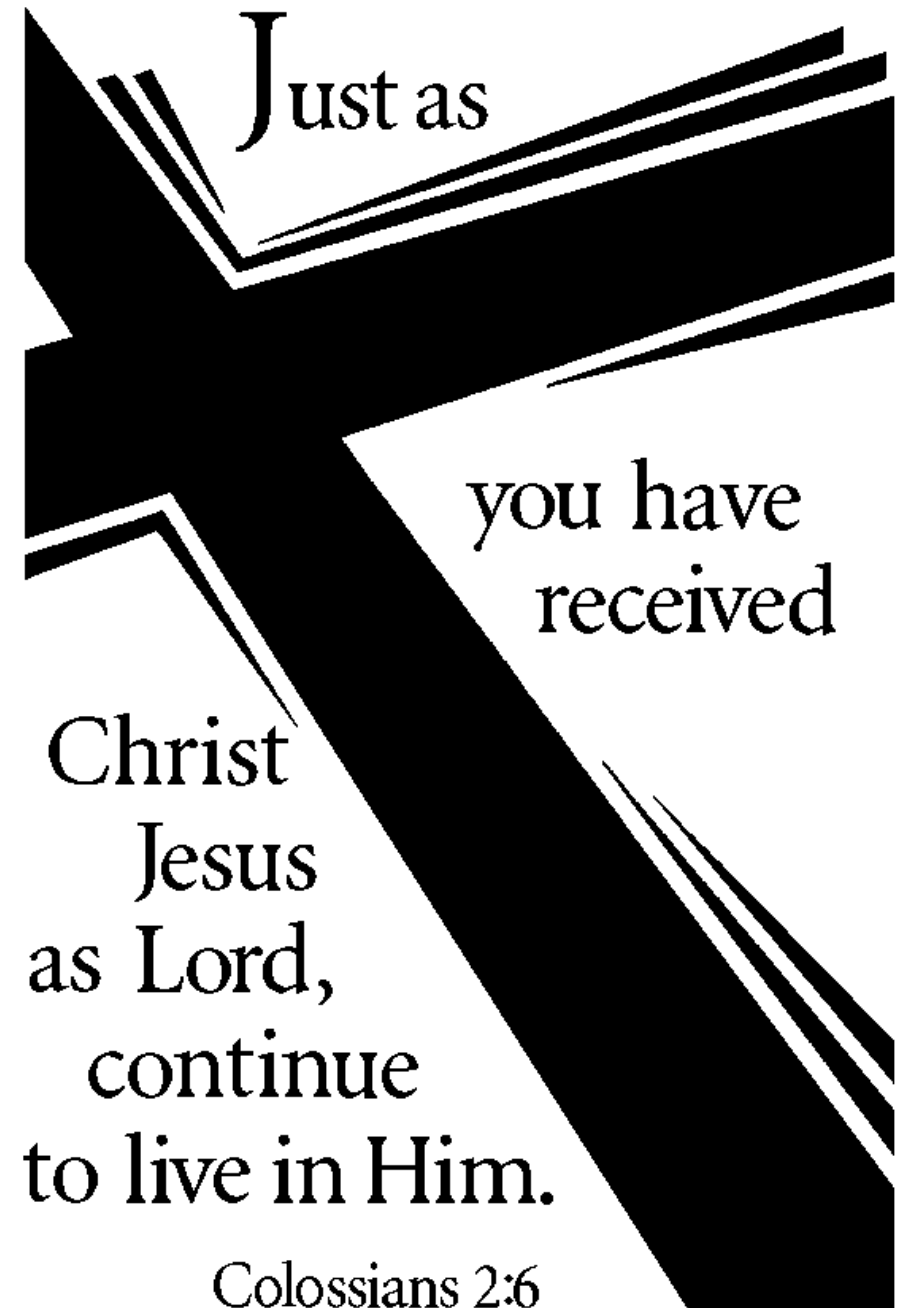
