

FINANCIAL UPDATE FROM THE SESSION

At our September Session meeting we reviewed the finances of the church, as we do at every meeting. We want to keep the congregation updated about our financial status as we near the end of the third quarter of the year. The good news is that giving to our Missions and Benevolence fund is strong. As of the end of August, we are ahead of budget by \$1096. Our summer months have been particularly robust for this fund. The news for the General Fund is not as rosy. We began strong and have been slowly tailing off. At the end of the first quarter, giving per month was over 9% above last year's pace. At the end of June, when the second guarter ended, that had declined to 4.7% above last year's giving. By the end of August, it was down to a negative 1.1%. That means we're giving slightly less than we gave last year, averaged out over the whole year. While it is not surprising that general fund giving is weaker during the summer, it does raise some concern about how we finish 2019. If giving for September through December is stronger, we will be close to meeting our budget. The Session would encourage the congregation to prayerfully consider these matters. We trust in the Lord, and look to Him to provide for all our needs. As we have prayed in the past, and given generously, we have seen Him bring in all that we have needed - He doesn't abandon His children or make us beg bread in the streets!
