## FELLOWSHIP LUNCH

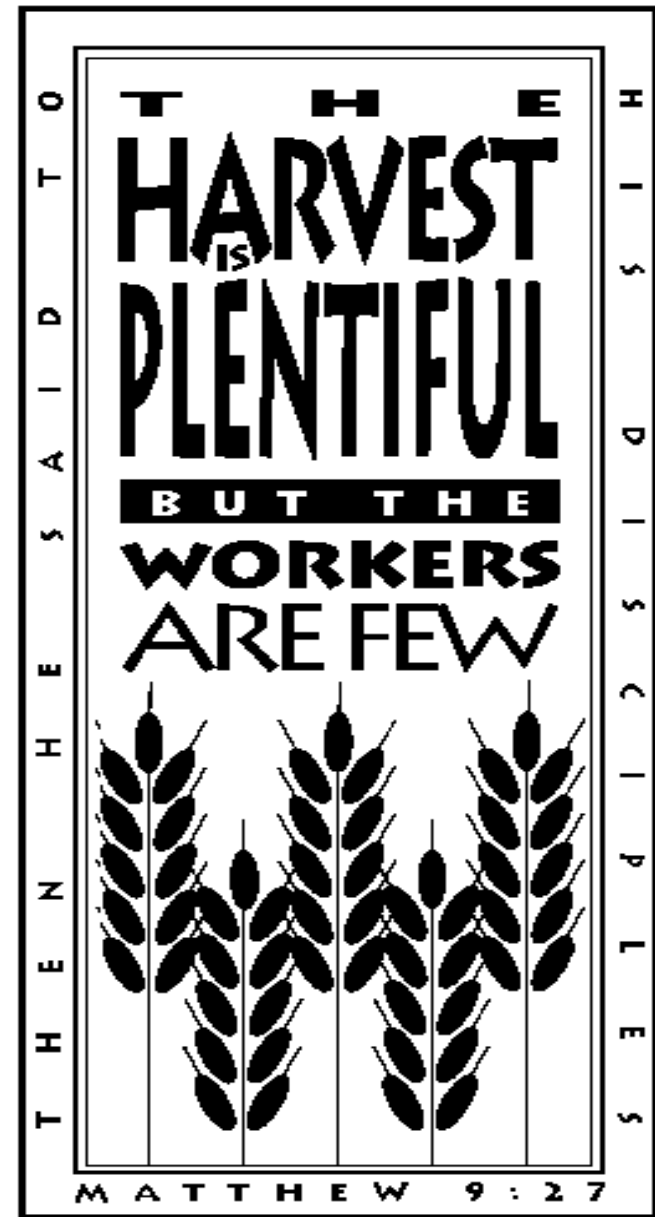
There will be a fellowship lunch on Sunday, November 1st following the Sunday School hour. Sign up today on the bulletin board.
