### ANNUAL THANKSGIVING SERVICE

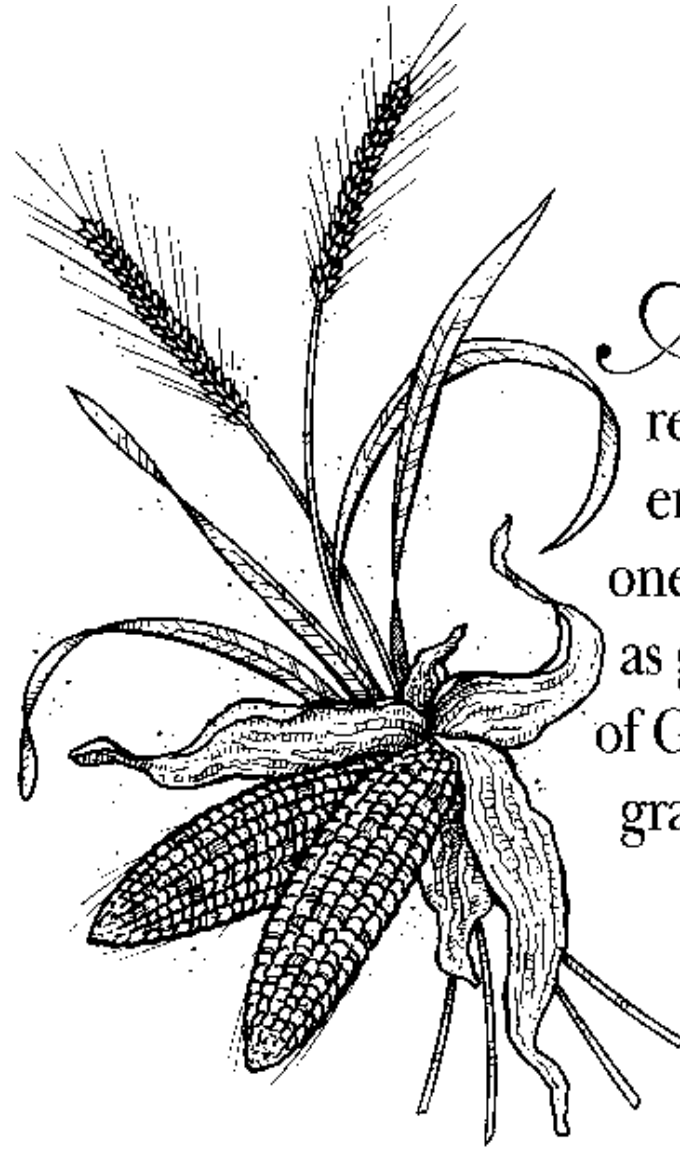
Our annual Thanksgiving service will be on Wednesday evening, November 27th at 7:00pm.
